

- 1. The site contractor is responsible for the protections of the existing parking lots, sidewalks & curbs to include any and all repairs at project completion to restore to existing conditions.
- 2. All site work shall comply with the NPDEES permit and the designated phasing.
- 3. The site contractor shall establish and maintain two wheel wash stations (One access to Rich Valley Road, one accessing the site)
- 4. No construction traffic or deliveries are permitted in the bus loops and parent drop off routes during the hours of 8:40 AM to 9:10 AM and 3:30 4:30 PM
 5. All contractors are to receive the district's approval prior to to locating and starting any crane hoists. No hoisting over occupied school areas

This site logistics plan is provided as a general reference document for all contractors and their subcontractors for a quide on how the project will be organized. The focus is on student/staff safety, daily school traffic flows and building construction. Any work, not shown or necessary to the work. is hereby understood to be the responsibility of the prime contractors and therefore is part of the bids and contract work. 
Site Plan

All subcontractors and suppliers should familiarize themselves with the bid package descriptions found in the Specification Sections so they can direct their quotations to the correct Prime Contractor.

INSURANCE

The School District will be implementing an Owner-Controlled Insurance Program. By submitting a bid, the Contractor is certifying that it has excluded all insurance costs from the Base Bid, Alternates and Unit Prices with respect to those insurance coverages that will be provided by the School District in accordance with the General Conditions Paragraph 11 – Insurance.

BID SECURITY/BONDS

Bid security or bid bond in the amount of 10% of base bid shall be included with each proposal copy.

WAGE RATES

Project is subject to Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act. Certified payrolls will be required on a monthly basis with applications for payment. Current rates are included in the specifications.

TAXES

Bidders are directed to review the PA Tax Exempt Entities, Section 000860. Contractors will be responsible for sales tax, consumer, and use taxes as required by law. Contractors are directed to the PA. Sales & Use Tax Guide to determine which items are taxable/tax exempt. The Cumberland Valley School District reserves the right to pursue sales tax paid to the State in error.

Additional Information

PERFORMANCE/PAYMENT/BONDS

Successful contractors will be required to provide Performance and Payment Bonds. Performance, Payment and Bid Bonds must be submitted on forms provided in the documents. Surety companies must be legally authorized to do business in the State of Pennsylvania and must be listed in the latest U.S. Treasury Department Circular 570.

SUBSTITUTIONS

All substitutions must be submitted to the Architect <u>no later than 60 days after the intent to award contracts is issued</u>. Contractors are directed to use "Substitution Request Form" found in Section 012500. Unless materials have been accepted by Addendum, materials and equipment shall be furnished and installed as per the specifications.

MISCELLANEOUS ISSUES


